New BSNM Champions: Khadeejah Maeyouf and Dr Eeshani Bendale

A big welcome to Khadeejah Maeyouf (University of Strathclyde) and Dr Eeshani Bendale (Oxford University) who have joined the team of BSNM champions.

Khadeejah is a PhD student with Dr Christine Dufès. Her project is based on the development of novel tumour-targeted nanomedicines entrapping docetaxel and the evaluation of their targeting and therapeutic efficacy in vitro and in vivo on prostate cancer.

Dr Eeshani Bendale is a physician of Ayurveda which is an Indian medical science. During her studies she developed an interest in the use of nanoparticles in Ayurvedic formulations, which led her to join the MSc Nanomedicine programme in Swansea University. She is the first Ayurvedic Physician to get admitted to the University of Oxford, where she is currently pursuing an MSc in Evidence-Based Healthcare.

BSNM Annual Meeting 2022: Swansea University

On the 22nd-23rd August, the BSNM held their Annual Meeting in Swansea University; the first in-person conference since the Covid-19 pandemic. We were delighted to welcome delegates from across the country and play host to an amazing programme of scientific research.

Professor Steve Conlan was on hand to open the conference and were joined by Professor Arwyn Jones (Cardiff University), Dr Paul Hole (ReNeuron), Dr Elaine Ferguson (Cardiff University), Professor Andrew Owen (University of Liverpool), Beth Hinchliffe (National Physical Laboratory) and Professor Karmalinder Singh (University of Central Lancaster) as session leads.

Over the course of the two-day event, conference participants had the opportunity to hear about a wide range of research topics, ranging from novel nanomaterials and nanoparticles for drug delivery to nanoparticle fabrication, nanobiological interactions, and innovative microbial applications for nanomaterials. The discussion groups on nano toxicology and nanoparticle characterisation, chaired by Swansea University's Kirsty Meldrum and Kadie Edwards were a big hit and ended the conference on a positive, collaborative note. Poster and oral presentation winners were Owen Harrison (King's College London) and Pratik Gurnani (University of Nottingham), for their presentations on the "Development and optimisation of in vitro blood-brain-barrier models to study the impact of ultrasound and cavitation-mediated mechanical forces" and "self-amplifying RNA delivery using charge reversal polymers", respectively.
